877/16 Planning App DC.2015/ 00678 Plot 1 Swn-Yr-Afon, Tredunnoch.

878/16 Flooding

Cllr Williams reviewed key points raised in a Flood Prevention Consultation Report from Monmouthshire County Council. The report provided information on local areas detailing flood risk areas for properties and land in the area.

879/16 Flooding on Candwr Road
